



## CHALLENGER BASEBALL CANADA TRAVEL GRANTS INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Challenger Baseball Canada budgets \$7000 annually to help assist programs travelling to Challenger Baseball events.
2. Travel grants are only available to chartered programs who are in good standing with Challenger Baseball Canada.
3. To be eligible, programs must be travelling to a Challenger Baseball event with a minimum of 5 players.
4. Programs can apply for up to \$200 per player attending the event.
5. Eligible events include, but are not limited to, the National Jamboree, Provincial Jamborees or the Little League World Series.
6. The application process will open annually on November 1<sup>st</sup>.
7. The application process will close annually on March 1<sup>st</sup>.
8. All grant applications must be emailed to **randy.crouse@hotmail.com** by 11pm (Atlantic Time) on March 1<sup>st</sup> annually.
9. Please note that not all requests will be granted, and not all applicants will receive the full requested amounts.
10. All grant applications will be reviewed by the Challenger Baseball Canada National Coordinator and Provincial Coordinators.
11. Successful grant applications will be determined by the Challenger Baseball Canada National Coordinator and Provincial Coordinators.
12. Programs that receive funding from Challenger Baseball Canada will be required to email (**randy.crouse@hotmail.com**) a minimum of two photos from the event. If possible, at least one photo should be a team photo.
